- Debrief of Chancellor Meeting
 - To hear back by next week on Tuesday
 - Indicated support for e2 but was trying to offer options of 5 and 10-year funding (to later be discussed by the board)
- Group Discussion: Next Steps After the Chancellor Meeting (Sticking to permanent funding)
 - Being strategic about the language we use in not writing a year or date; also to have language that matches the faculty endorsements
 - Highlighting the endorsements of students and faculty that were for <u>permanent</u> <u>funding</u>
 - Finding that point person for e2 to connect with in regard for receiving those funds
 - Identifying a permanent date for us to receive that funding for transparency and accountability (Week 6 of Fall Quarter)
 - It is important to honor all of the students and faculty who support this movement
 - Adding a "permanent funding line" for specificity
 - Follow Up to be expected with missing board members on this discussion before emailing the Chancellor's office
