 - Co-Chair, KM: Favorite birthday?
- SAPEP Recap
 - PO, JG:Asking for plan for the next 3 years
 - Update: increased JUSTICE Funding for next 2 years, this year will focus on extra funding for community college outreach
 - Tours have a huge impact on BIPOC/CC Students



- Less of a connection for college aged folks, less mentors to connect students (lack of funding)
- OurStory (10:35am-11:45am) (70 mins)
 - PO, JG: Legacy of longer piece of struggle across our communities
 - Obstacles currently occurring
 - Breakouts: What's something that you didn't know? + Time to reflect on our own history, considering family/ personal experience
- Break (11:45am-11:50am)
 - Lunch: Woodstocks
- Strike (11:50am-12:20pm) (30 mins)
 - CC, KM: Reflections on food pantry
 - Students were grateful for the distribution
 - Many found out about e2 from the program
 - Stated that it was necessary/preferential to UCSC dining
 - Other impacts on students
 - Orgs reassess their member body meetings to accommodate with shifted dining hours
 - Students of APISA appreciative to have a place for discussion
 - MC: target frustration toward the University, not the strikers
 - ATAT: Feeling of uncertainty, but negative affects a result of unfair circumstances
 - Context
 - CC, DR: TA's not given a liveable wage, engaging in legally protected strike
 - CC: Statement of Solidarity
 - PO, JG: How do people feel?
 - RBT, SG: in favor, to show University's faults



- MC, JJ: supports, but concerned about impact on funding for e2
 - PO, JG: important to consider legacy, but statement has no relation to UCOP
 - Union has external support financially, but symbolic support/statements needed
 - Level of advocacy as a form to universities inattentiveness
- UMOJA, NS: How will pay be affected?
 - PO, JG: payment for TA's does not come out of student fees, they are paid %3 of certain budget
 - ADV., SF: they are asking for a shift in how Uni. prioritizes their budget
 - Education on the demands to the general public necessary to prevent resentment for movement
- UMOJA, NS: grades?
 - CC, DR: depends on the TA's
 - ADV., SF: re-emphasizing advocating for strikers and providing transparency for undergrads and what to expect, grade wise
 - MC, JJ: Uni. Spent large budget each day to fund police surveillance over tending to Union demands. Tending to these demands directly improves the undergrad experience
- CC, KM: Call for a VOTE Solidarity Statement
 - CHALE Motions for e2 to put out statement and advocate for admin to address uncertainty that undergrads facing
 - MC Seconds
 - ASF approves
 - DHE approves
 - MC approves

- Going over Solidarity Statement
 - RBT, SG: asking for grades could lead to consequences on TA's
 - ADV., SF: add that university should be held accountable and the repercussions should not fall on the undergrads
 - PC, LM: reemphasize decision made should be equally equitable to everyone affected, strikers and undergrads collectively
 - CC, KM: feedback will be taken in
 - CC, DR: need support working on letter to admin
 - ADV., SF: Can expand on last section of letter
 - One public statement and one to admin directly
